Regardless of the match-up, 28-year-old Lyndie Burris, another Clay County native, who grew up with Weeks, said she's thrilled about the upcoming concert.

"The Super Bowl is a huge event for the Clay County area, to see the growth and the community come together is very exciting," said the Middleburg High School graduate of 1994.

Burris spent two years in Nashville but said nothing happened for her musically.

"I learned to wait tables really well," she said.

Meanwhile, she's a local celebrity of sorts performing three nights a week in North Florida. She runs karaoke night on Wednesday nights at Coyote's Oyster Bar and Grill on Park Avenue. She performs from 7 to 10 p.m. Thursday nights at Baxter's Wings and Things in Clay County and at Palencia Golf Club from 6 to 9 p.m. Saturdays in St. Augustine.

In May 2003, she won WJXT TV-4's Gimme the Mike competition. Her last big show was opening for Buddy Jewel at the 2004 Ham Jam.

She lives in Orange Park with her husband Wynn Perry of Tennessee, a professional musician who tours the country with his band, The Wynn Perry Band. Burris said she doesn't go on the road with him but occasionally performs with them as a featured act.
